- **Yale - NUS, Singapore – FULL SCHOLARSHIP**
- **Tulane University – PARTIAL TUITION (Merit Based)** One of the most prestigious merit scholarships, the Tulane University South Asian Scholar Award. Out of a field of applicants of unprecedented strength and quality, the committee awards scholarship to very select cohort from South Asia.
- **Boston University – FULL TUITION (Merit Based)** Every year, BU welcomes approximately 20 outstanding students to the Trustee Scholars Program.
- **University of Richmond – FULL SCHOLARSHIP (Merit Based)** The University's most prestigious academic award, Richmond Scholarship is equal to full tuition, room & board, in addition to other program benefits, and is given to 25 incoming students.
- **Mount Allison University, Canada – (Merit Based)** Scholarship and International Award granted .
