# THE BIS STORY & EDUCATION **PHILOSOPHY**

BIS was founded on a dream envisioned by parents. This emerged from a longing to break away from constraints of traditional educational systems and to allow children to question, explore ideas and to give wings to their

The vision was to have an ecosystem where education was perceived as a wondrous discovery. Education at Bombay International School (BIS) is thus a collaborative effort, where parents, teachers and students work together so that children have the freedom to pursue individual passions and discover their true interests. Armed with holistic education that fosters liberal-mindedness, children step into the world as empowered, empathetic adults, infused with idealism, practicality and the desire to make the world a better place.

BIS inculcates in its students, a spirit of compassion, collaboration and habits of the mind that include self-regulation, self-awareness, creativity, communication, critical thinking and research skills. Our faculty comprises a diverse group of educators who are passionate about teaching and learning and who apply the principles of constructivism, inquiry and concept-based learning inside their classrooms.

# **ENROLLMENT**

All students are registered for the full IB Diploma. With guidance, students choose subjects based on their passion, interest and further education choices. They are given freedom to choose and students are allowed to pursue three sciences in case they wish to pursue medicine. All students complete the core IB requirements of Theory of Knowledge, Extended Essay and CAS (Creativity, Activity and Service) which adds to a holistic approach with adequate rigour, depth and breadth.

# SERVICE LEARNING THROUGH CAS (CREATIVITY, ACTIVITY, SERVICE)

A healthy balance is achieved between all three strands of CAS and this is built into the Diploma Programme. Students participate in multifaceted school-led creative experiences through stage performances, dance and art and community service every week over a period of 18 months with guidance from the CAS Coordinator and CAS advisors. Additionally, special projects initiated by students are enthusiastically supported by the school. Over the years, students have initiated learning and sharing clubs for Math, Chess, Music, MUN, Cooking, Dance, Yoga and Visual Art. Sporting activities include football, swimming, chess, badminton, squash, cricket, horse riding and self-defence. Students also participate in 'Skill Quest' where they choose between between art, improvisational theatre, robotics and sports.

As part of our commitment to community service, the "IB Together" program 'Lil Champs' pairs senior students with younger ones (lower and upper preparatory students) for engaging activities like music, dance, drama, and art. In addition, our students collaborate with NGOs such as Parakh Dharamshala, Seva Sadan, Jai Vakeel, and Toybank. Additionally, we organize CAS Camps in remote areas where students have the opportunity to challenge themselves in new ways and serve underprivileged populations they may not encounter in a city like Mumbai.



# STUDENT PROFILE



# UNIVERSITY APPLICATION LIMIT

At BIS, we prioritize well-informed decisions for students and universities in the application process. As part of this commitment, we have set a limit of 15 applications worldwide for our students. This approach helps colleges and universities identify genuine interest in applications of BIS students.

# MENTORING & PEER SUPPORT GROUP

The Peer Support Group (PSG) is an approachable and trained student body available for students as a support structure for emotional wellbeing. Whilst the peer supporters are not professional counsellors, they undergo intensive training to equip them with skills needed to fulfill their roles. The current PSG for the academic year 2025-2026 comprises five students. They are Aditi Moondhra, Nia Haydn D'Souza Ganapathy Sahana Gautam and Aadit Shah.

The mentorship programme in the IBDP provides a space for conversations and one-on-one relationships between teachers and students. Teacher mentors encourage students to self-reflect, step out of their comfort zone and help students identify and work through academic challenges by equipping them with skills of independent learning.



# ASSESSMENT AND REPORTING

Report cards are issued at the end of each term with three types of grades generated over two

Achievement Grade: reflects continuous assessment of knowledge, concepts and skills attained by students in all assessments and tests taken in a subject over the term.

Exam Grade: reflects assessment of knowledge, concepts and skills in end of term examinations aligned with IBDP subject-specific assessment objectives and grade descriptors.

Effort Grade: demonstrates student effort in all learning engagements during the term and takes into account progression on several skills and dispositions.

Early Predicted Grades (PGs) were released in June 2025 and are reviewed in December 2025 to generate Regular PGs. There is very close correlation between our predicted grades and final IB Diploma results which the school has consistently maintained since 2014.
